We have an incredible opportunity for aspiring doctors in year 11, 12 and 13 to take part in our Access to Medicine – Work Experience course. Specifically designed for students looking to boost their personal statement and have real-life experiences to discuss in their medical school interviews.

Students can join us at any of our three projects, India, Transylvania or Kilimanjaro. This is a structured and supervised trip where students gain a mixture of hospital based work experience, interview training, clinical training and advice & guidance. Each course includes:

- 25 hours shadowing Doctor/Consultant per week
- 1 x Interview workshop per week
- 1 x MMI simulation with feedback
- 1 x Panel interview simulation with feedback
- 2 x Clinical training sessions per week
- Advice & guidance from current UK medical student
- Personal statement review and advice
- Private accommodation for our students

- Easter 2017 – Half Term
- Summer 2017 – Summer Break
